## Psalm 91

1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.  
2 I will say[a] to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

## Dwell Definition

To sit or to remain. Or to trust in.

The choices you make today will impact your tomorrow.

## 1 John 4:16

And we have known and believed the love that God hath for us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.

## Matthew 5:11-12

"Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. 12Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

## 1 Corinthians 10:13

**Abide - "He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty."**

**Abide means to accept or act in accordance with (a rule, decision, or recommendation).**

## John 15:5

5 "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."
