The world loves to look at the Jesus that they've created through the lens of the culture that they now live in.

Matthew 13:34-35 (ESV)

All these things Jesus said to the crowds in parables; indeed, he said nothing to them without a parable. 35 This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet: “I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter what has been hidden since the foundation of the world.”

Matthew 13:44 (ESV)

The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

God doesn't see any part of you as inconsequential because he sees your potential.

Matthew 13:45-46 (ESV)

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls, 46 who, on finding one pearl of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

God is great, so he put greatness within you. God is good, so he put goodness inside of you. God is love, so he put love inside of you. God created you to create. He imagined you to imagine. He made you a work of art to make artwork.

You're worth everything to God.

Matthew 13:47-52 (ESV)

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was thrown into the sea and gathered fish of every kind. 48 When it was full, men drew it ashore and sat down and sorted the good into containers but threw away the bad. 49 So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come out and separate the evil from the righteous 50 and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
